PROJECT SUMMARY

The scope of work required on this Project was the upgrade and expansion of the gravel runway at Rio Tinto's Boolgeeda Aerodrome.

Joint venture partners Eastern Guruma and NRW, carried out the works which included over 300,000 cubic metres of fill to construct a 2.2 kilometre by 45 metre wide bitumen sealed runway, complete with a new taxiway and apron, serviced by a new access road and car park.

The scope also included ground works and in-ground services for new terminal buildings and airport.

The upgrade took approximately seven months to complete, and had a peak workforce of approximately 70 people.
